

United Airlines opens employee clinic at O'Hare

Any employee of United Airlines who passes through O'Hare International Airport may stop by the organization's new health clinic for treatment of routine illnesses, flu shots, employment-related physicals and other services.

The 5,200-square-foot free clinic also is open to United's 10,000 Chicago-area employees. It is the airline's fifth employee clinic; others are at airports in Cleveland, Houston, Guam and Newark/New York. All of the clinics are managed by Walgreens, which operates 370 employer-based clinics for other companies.
