

# OSHA inspectors beat a path to Bensalem, Pa. construction firm

Inspectors from the U.S. Department of Labor's Occupational Safety and Health Administration have a reputation for efficiency. Rather than choosing random worksites to inspect, they go where they think they'll find violations.

Strong Contractors in Bensalem, Pa. has become the go-to destination for OSHA inspectors. Since March 2017, they have descended on Strong worksites 14 times. In the most recent OSHA visit, inspectors found Strong employees working on a steep church roof, more than 20 feet above the ground, with no fall protections in place.

Additionally, OSHA claims the company failed to provide appropriate eye protection to its employees.

The price of this round in OSHA's cross-hairs is \$110,971 in penalties.
